**Catholic Schools Week
 January 27- February 2**

Since 1974, National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It starts the last Sunday in January and runs all week, which in 2019 is January 27 - February 2. The theme for the National Catholic Schools Week 2019 is "Learn, Serve, Lead, Succeed"

Our school will celebrate everyday with special dress days, snacks, movies, games, basketball, mass and service projects! We will thank our volunteers with a brunch, share our talents with one another and help those who are less fortunate. Through these events, Catholic schools focus on the value Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our church, our communities and our nation.

Children often say "this is the BEST week of the year!! We are proud to celebrate that we go to St. Paul School!"

Information for Special days during Catholic Schools Week

Dress up days—Each day will be a special dress day. Your child may wear the item highlighted for that day. Monday is Pajama Day (students wear pajamas all day or change into them at noon), Tuesday is Sports and Hat Day (wear the hat of your choice all day and your favorite sports team), Wednesday is Crazy Hair Day (wear your hair as crazy as you want), Thursday is Super Hero Day (wear your favorite Super Hero), Friday is St. Paul Green and White Day (wear St. Paul colors, shirts etc.).

Hobby/Collection Day—Students are encouraged to bring a collection, hobby or whatever they would like to display on a desk or table top for the entire school to view. Each grade will have a chance to walk through the other classes during the Hobby Fair. No pets or animals should be brought to school—it is difficult for the pets and for the teachers to monitor in a safe way for everyone involved. If someone wants to share their pet as a hobby, it should be done with photos.

Volunteer Brunch and Mass—Volunteers will be invited to a luncheon hosted by the teachers on Saturday, January 25 as a way for us to say thank you for all that they do. We are inviting all to Mass.

Movie/Game Day—Students may bring games from home or movies to share with their class. The school will provide the drinks and snacks.

Free Throw Contest—Students in grades K-4 will have the chance to shoot free throws and compete for prizes.

5th-6th Basketball—Students in grades K-4 will watch the fifth and sixth graders play basketball. The teachers will serve popcorn and soda during this time to all students.

Teacher Appreciation—The sixth grade class will serve snacks to the teachers throughout the week to show their appreciation. A luncheon will also be held on Feb 1.

Mass—All students that attend St. Paul School are encouraged to attend the 5:15 mass on Saturday, Jan 26. Plan on coming and celebrating our school heritage.

Special Treats at Lunch—On Tues., Jan 30 students will have a dessert bar in the lunchroom. All students will have a chance to get items from this dessert bar. Then on Thursday, Feb. 1 students will have an appetizer bar in the lunchroom.

Service Project- We would like for the students to bring in donations for our local nursing homes: slipper socks (with grips), Dove body wash, fingernail polish, Kleenex plush and large print word search books. Along with cards written by the students, these items will be delivered to all area nursing homes. Please send donations to school by Monday, Jan 28. Thanks for your help!
